Organization Committee of 1<sup>st</sup> Asian Martial Arts Games MAMAGOC is glad to inform you according to the MGCA rules and regulations the following Martial Arts are member games and rules and regulations from continental Federations MGCA member in Games is applicable:

- 1 - Karate
- 2 - Kickboxing
- 3 - Taekwon-Do
- 4 - Oriental
- 5 - Kung fu
- 6 - Muay Thai

2 - Each fighter is allowed only Participate in the one of Martial Arts.

3 - In each Martial Art will promote 5 weights categories for each fighting system for men and 3 weights for women. Totally each kind of Martial arts can organize 18 categories. Please receive the competition weights from respective Asian federations.

4- Kickboxing and Oriental Martial Arts because of frequency of champion styles will compete in 2 styles that totally kickboxing sport will offer 18 medals and Oriental sport will offer 18 medals too.

5 - Champion in 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> in each Martial Art will ATTAIN Gold Medal and champion certification of Games and 1<sup>st</sup> champion in each competition will receive champion belt of MGCA.

6 -The competition will be run according to the MGCA Rules & Regulations.

7 –The all participant's expenditure towards accommodation, food, entry fee, transport etc., should be paid on arrival time, but 30% with entry's athletes will received at December.

8 - Participants will not be allowed without MGCA Athletics Passport

9 - Flag & Anthem: Please bring audio CD / Cassette tape of your National Anthem and 3 National Flags. (1) Table (2) 72 Cm x 120 Cm size 2 Nos

**Registration system and Details of fighter's Passport and ID cards**

Registration at 1<sup>st</sup> Asian Martial Arts Games is online via Games website.

Each country has a secret code that after receiving the confirmation to attendance in Games, that code given to MGCA representative or a person who introduced by MGCA for doing registration affairs of teams by email.

Then, Representative MGCA in each country can enter to registration part on Games site and do registration of fighters, referees, and coaches. So they will receive a confirmation of registration automatically and after specified time, they will receive an official invitation letter to catch visa and primary ID card via post mail.

After catching the visa and enter to Manila airport, primary ID cards will recapture from fighters, coaches and referees and they will receive secondary ID card (Main ID card).

There is complete explanation about registration methods and issuance of ID cards in different languages, on Website.

Each fighter, moreover the ID card, will receive a sport passport during registration and weight – in which this passport should be in fighter's hand during games until the end of Games.

**Accommodation, Transfer and Expenses**

**Accommodation of fighters:**

Organization Committee of Games MAMGOC programming accommodation of fighters and coaches in 2, 3 and 4 star hotel arbitrarily.

All fighters, coaches and attendants of teams should pay their accommodation expenses themselves.

- 1- The 2 star hotel ..... For per person, per night 25 \$
- 2- The 3 star hotel ..... For per person, per night 34 \$
- 3- The 4 star hotel ..... For per person, per night 60 \$

Accommodations will be 2 bed rooms inclusive breakfast and dinner.

**Accommodation of referees:**

Accommodation of referees will be in free 4 star hotel. Referees should be introduced behalf Asian Federations to MGCA and MAMAGOC and accommodation will be free for 6 referees in each Martial Art.

**Transportation:**

Transportation of all fighters, referees, and coaches and every day from hotel to stadiums and inverse is free.

Each fighter should pay 140 USA\$ (100 Euro) for registration, transportations and catching MGCA passport and ID card to Organization Committee MAMAGOC.

System of payment will perform via internet website after catching the confirmation behalf MGCA.

**Comment 1:** 30% amount of accommodation costs of each team with registration amount and catching ID card amount should settle to MAMAGOC account before the end of 23<sup>rd</sup> September.

**Comment 2:** Accommodation of fighters, coaches, and referees is only during 29<sup>th</sup> November – 5<sup>th</sup> December, and if a person wants stay more in hotel, he should pay the INCREASE expensive, and MAMAGOC has no GUARANTY in hotel prices.

Visa will perform simply, for countries that have Philippine embassy. But in some countries that don't have Philippine embassy, MAMAGOC will prepare visas with the other methods:

- 1- Via Philippine embassy in near country.
- 2- Via embassy of the other country in respective country.

Please don't forget that the following countries don't need to visa to enter to Philippine, but it doesn't mean they don't need to internet registration.

All specifications of those who travel to 1<sup>st</sup> Asian Martial Arts Games as referee, coach, fighter, attendant or even VIP, should be disposal Organization Committee of Games, also Internet pre- registration is necessary for all.
