Call for Abstracts

Participants are invited to submit abstracts for the 20th Biennial Conference of ISCPES 2017. For instructions in preparing abstracts, please read the following carefully before preparing your abstract:

- 1. Abstract must be written in English.
- 2. Each presenting author is permitted to submit not more than two abstracts for the 16th ISCPES Biennial Conference in the capacity of main author. If two abstracts are submitted, the best abstract will be considered with first priority and the second one will be allocated in regard to the schedule of availability or may be included as a poster presentation.
- 3. Figures and tables are not acceptable.
- 4. Maximum length of an abstract is 250 words. The title should be concise and descriptive of the work to be reported. Do not use any subtitles. Use Times New Roman font (font size 12) to write the text.
- 5. The author submitting the abstract should appear as the first named author and will be expected to present the work if it is accepted.
- 6. In the case of an empirical study, the abstract should give the objectives of the study, the approach and the methods used, the results obtained, and the conclusions reached.
- 7. Review papers should state clearly their purpose, the nature and scope of the evidence consulted, the conclusions drawn and any implications for future work or action.
- 8. The abstract submission form is available for download at www.iscpes-info.net.

 Abstracts must be submitted by using the abstract submission form and should reach the organizing committee before the published deadline.

9. Deadline for abstract submission is 30th March 2017.

- 10. The organizers reserve the right to accept or refuse an abstract, to designate papers either as poster or oral presentations and to allocate the presentation to an appropriate session. Notification of the acceptance or rejection of all duly and timely submitted abstracts will be e-mailed to submitting authors by 17th April 2017.
- 11. Submitting authors must register as conference delegates and pay the registration fee. Where registration fees have not been received in a timely manner, the abstract will not be published in the book of abstracts.
