### **Workshop Objective**

With over 200 million inactive citizens, physical inactivity has become one of the most pressing challenges in Europe. Despite growing scientific evidence and political attention on the benefits of promoting healthy lifestyles at national and European levels in recent years, the sedentary crisis is developing.

We believe there is an opportunity to reverse this trend and that cities have a fundamental role to play, especially when targeting physical activity in the school context.

What role can a city play? What are the main elements of an Active City? Which are the key success factors for active schools and active kids?

This workshop is open to anyone from city leaders, local representatives, urban planners to experts involved in promoting physical activity in urban areas. It will explore, discuss and challenge the main elements of an Active City.
