Dear Mr Schischlik,

Further to the preparatory meetings that took place within the framework of MINEPS VI, we wish to hereby confirm that the IOC and ANOC would welcome MINEPS VI considering support for the approach and initiatives already developed by the IOC and ANOC to:

- Facilitate and strengthen the cooperation and mutual understanding between national authorities and sports organisations, as summarised in the "Reference Document" in Annex 1; and
- Implement the Basic Principles of Good Governance within the Olympic Movement, as summarised in the "Reference Document" in Annex 2 (and further developed in specific and practical tools produced for the National Olympic Committees).

These joint efforts aim in particular at strengthening the governance of the sports organisations and ensuring productive relationships between governments and sports entities to develop sport, in line with the principle of "responsible autonomy" of the Olympic Movement established in the Olympic Charter and recognised in the 2014 and 2016 UN Resolutions (A/69/6 and A/71/160).
